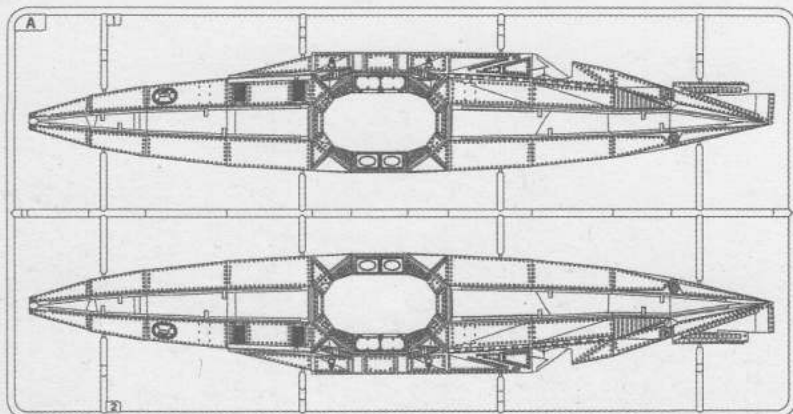
## *The Artist Signature Series*

Bringing together some of the most talented artist's and designers in the industry, this series offers some of the coolest designs ever available in a modeling kit!

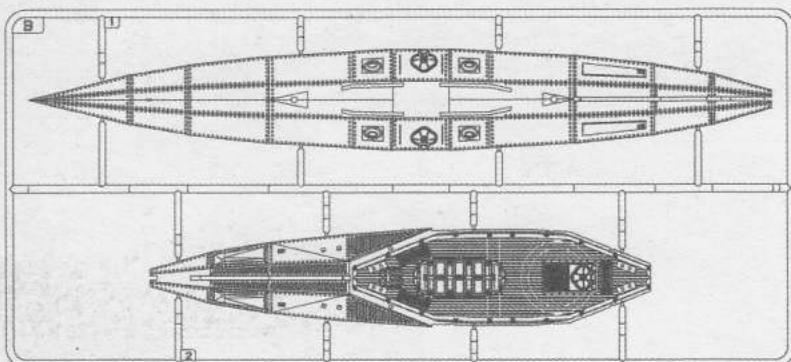

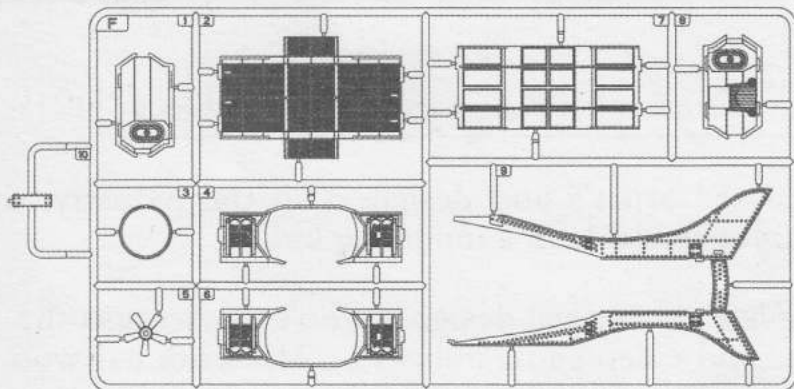
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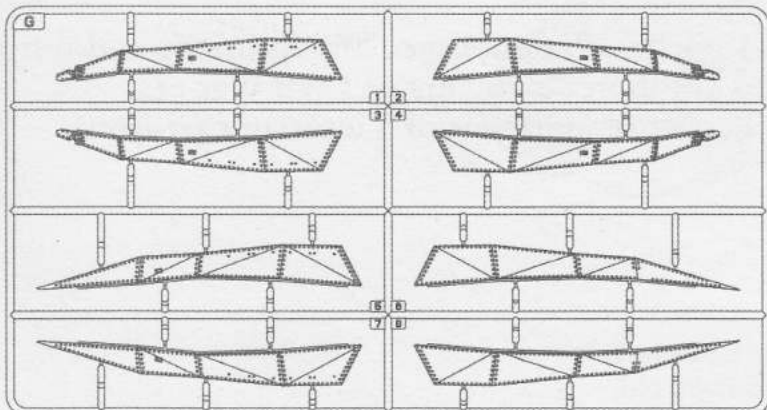
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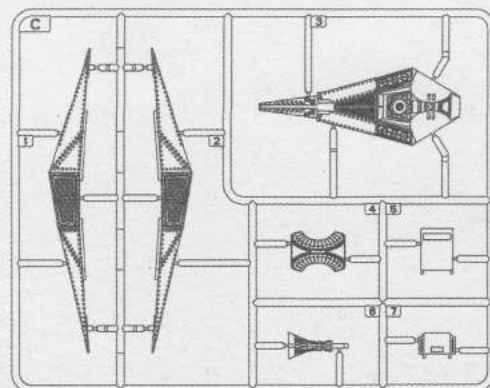
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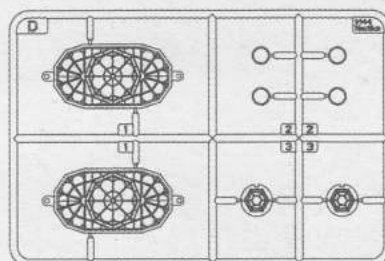
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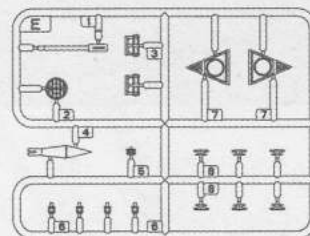
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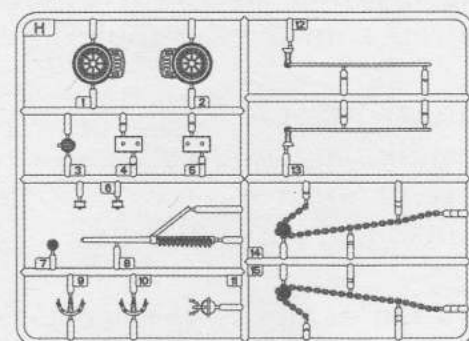
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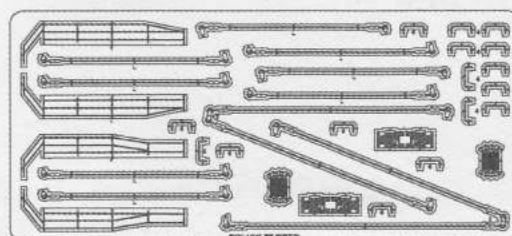
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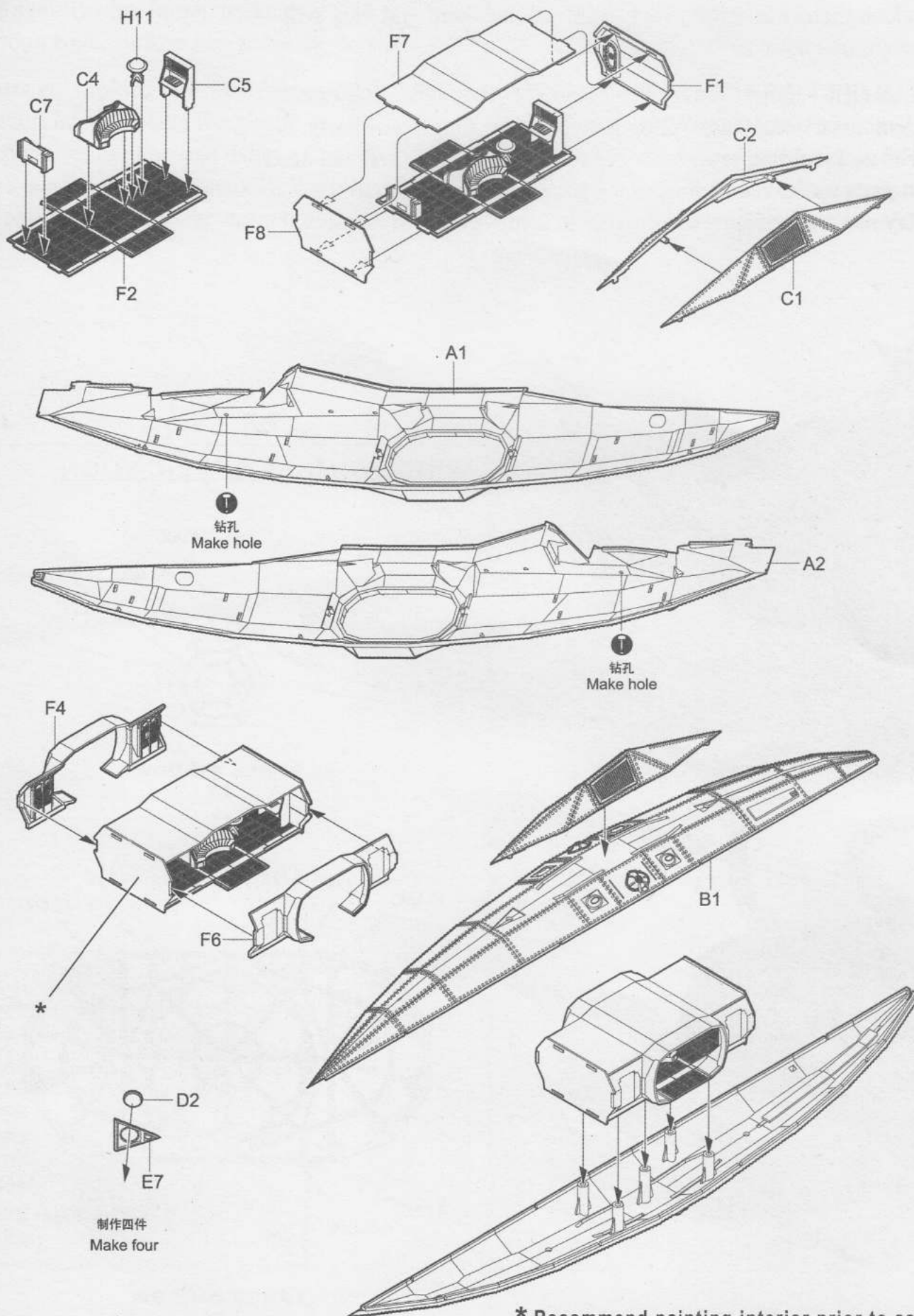
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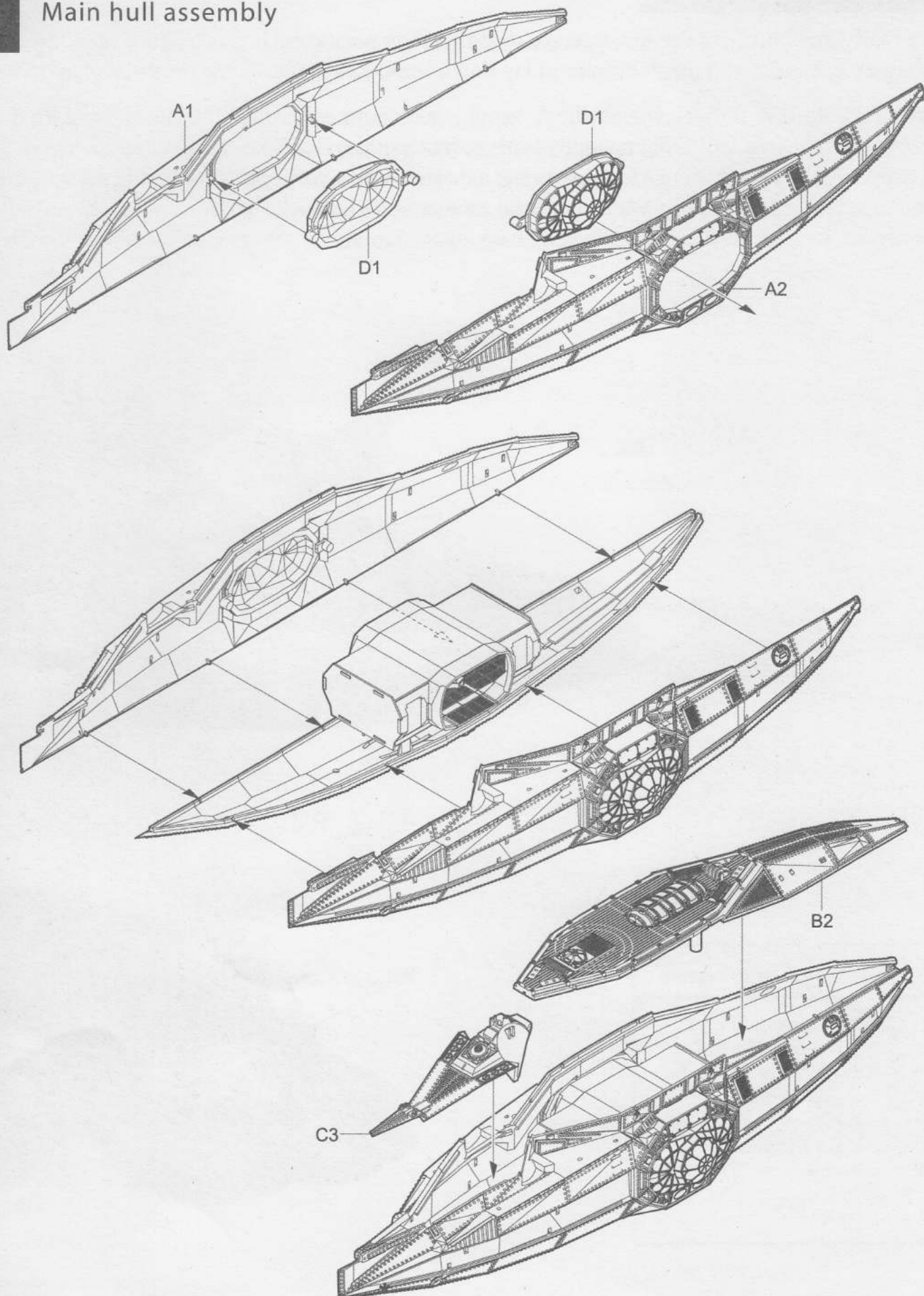
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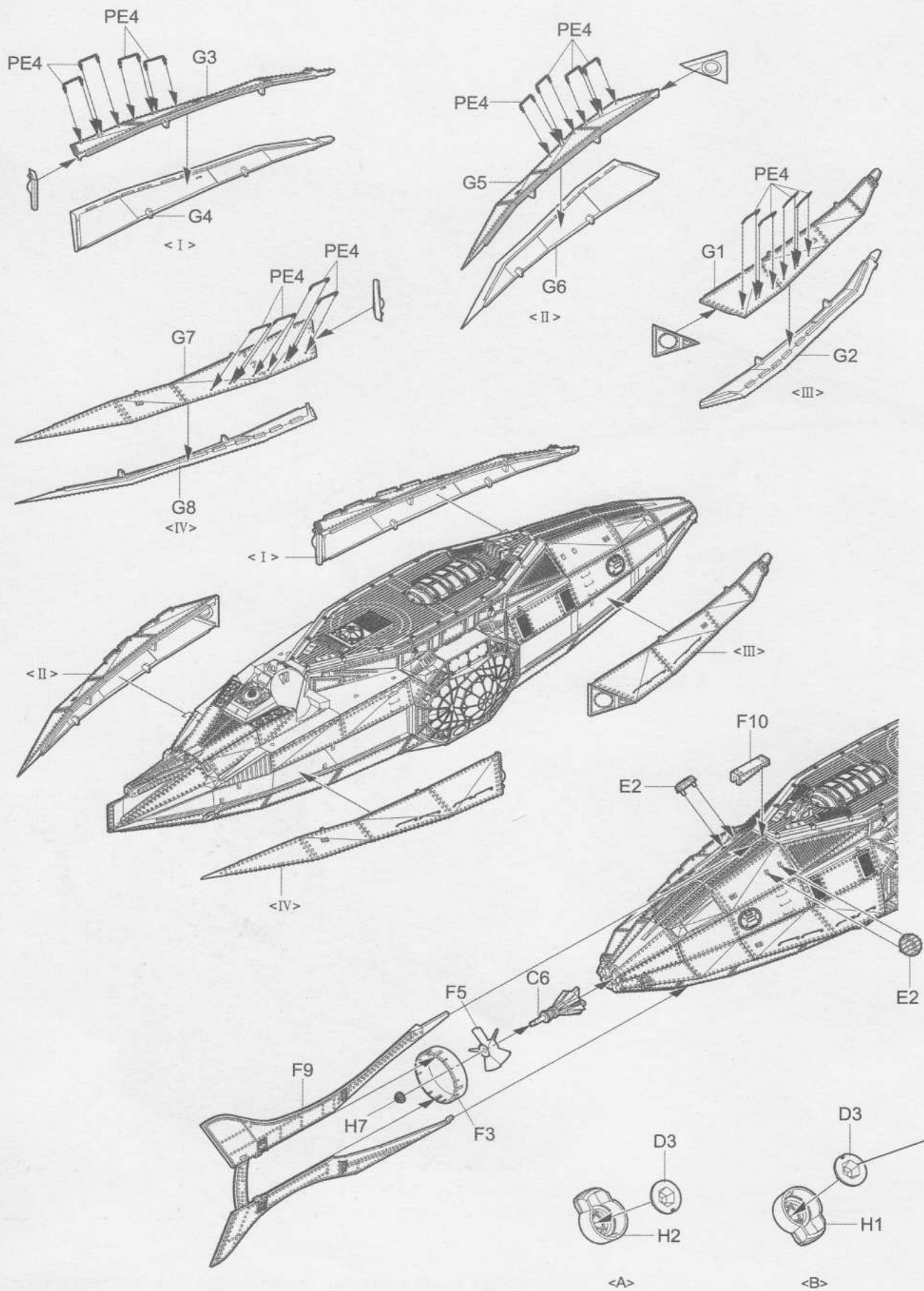
## Interior assembly and mounting



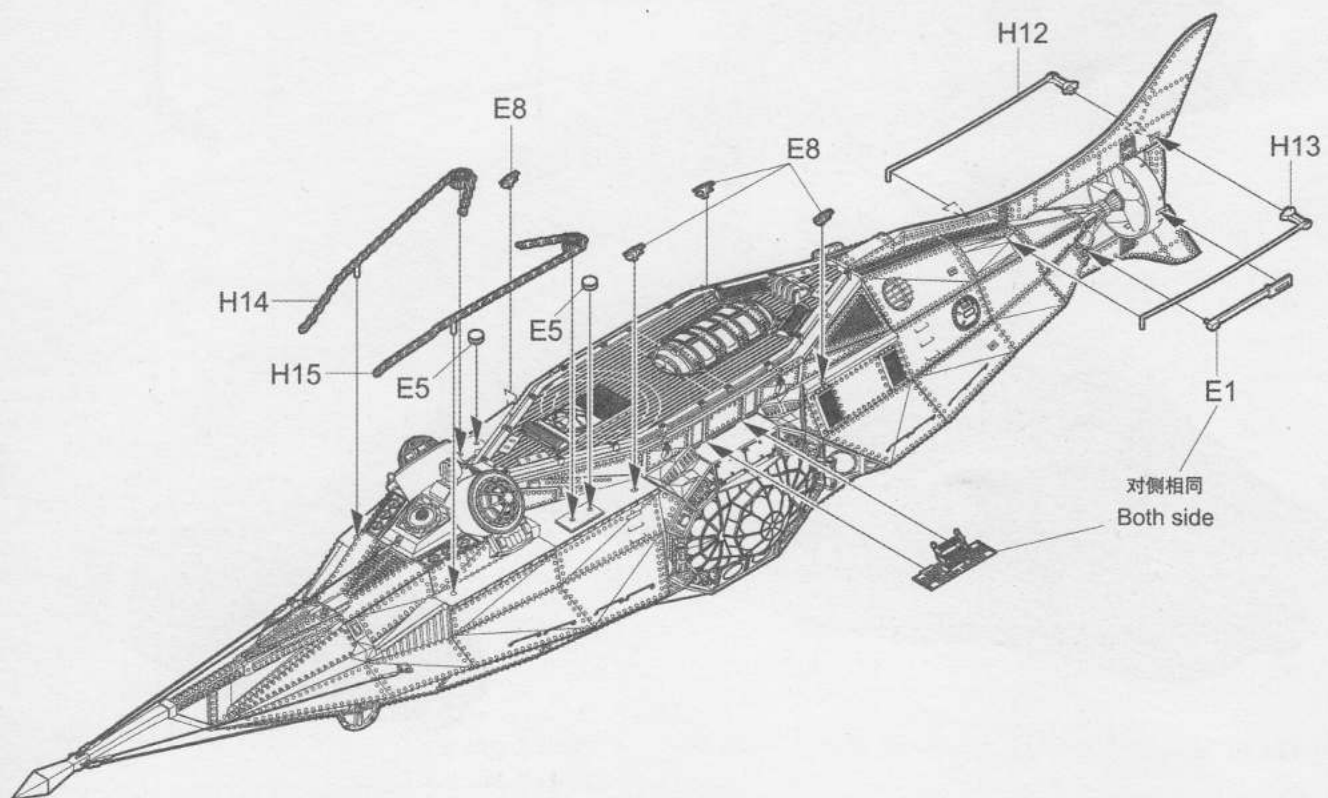
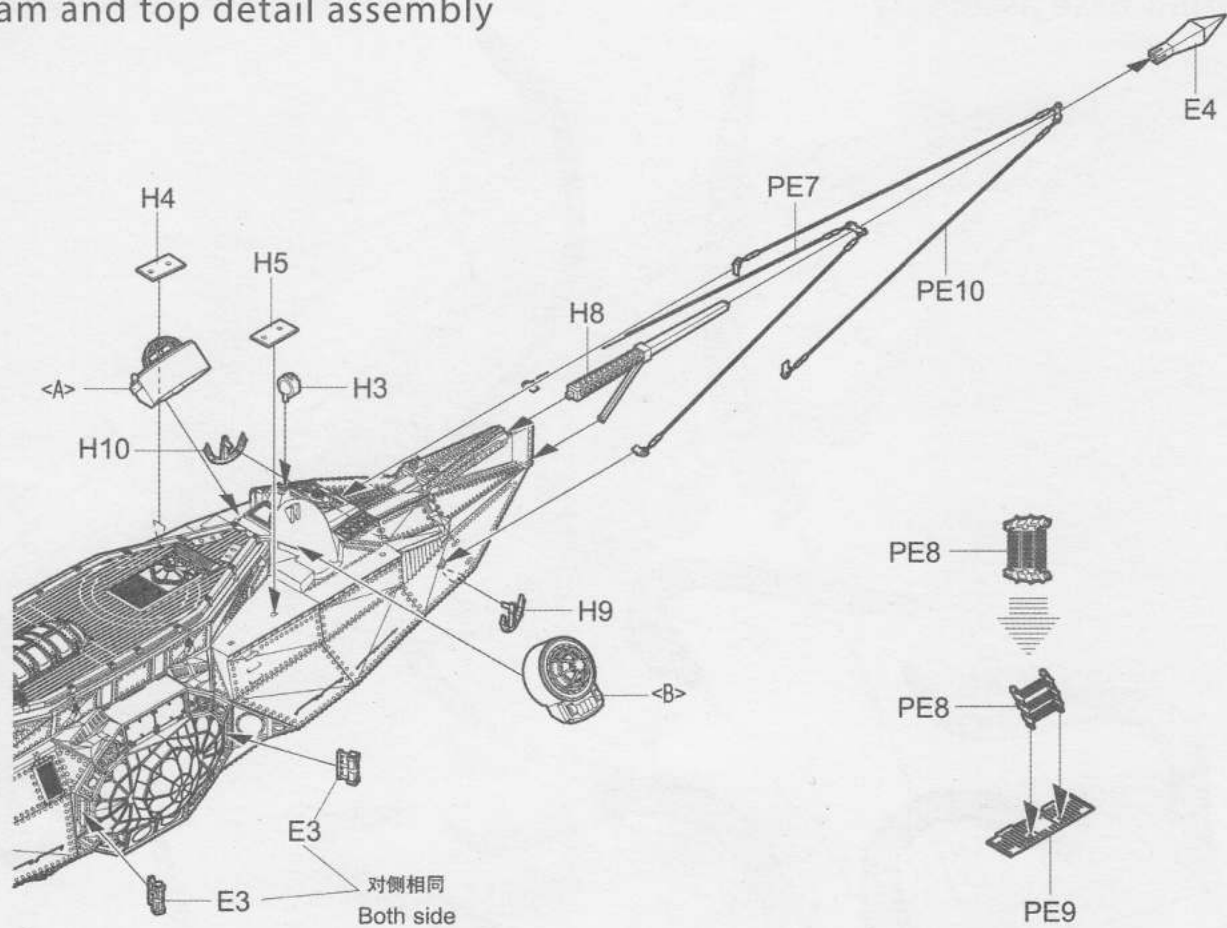


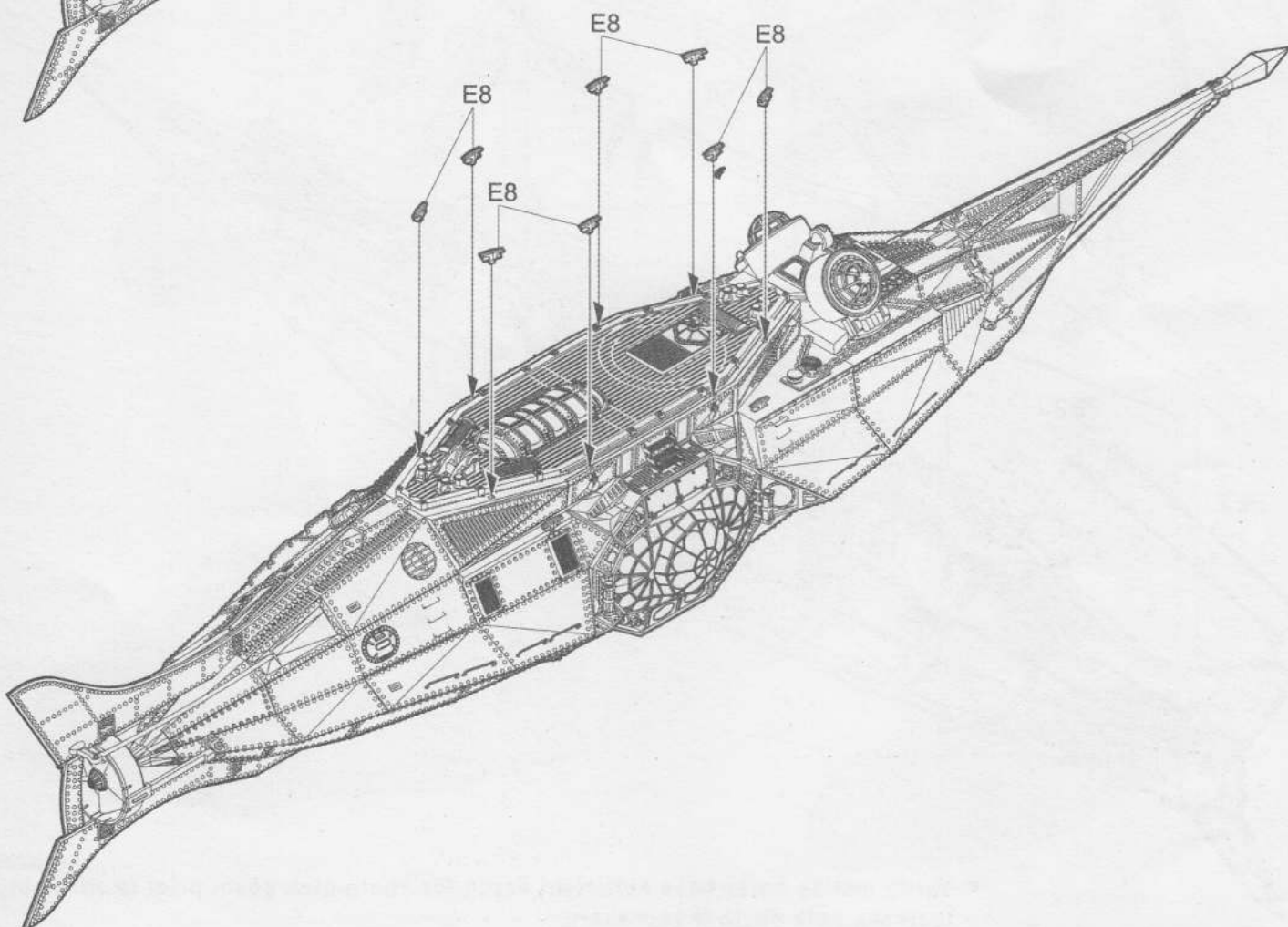
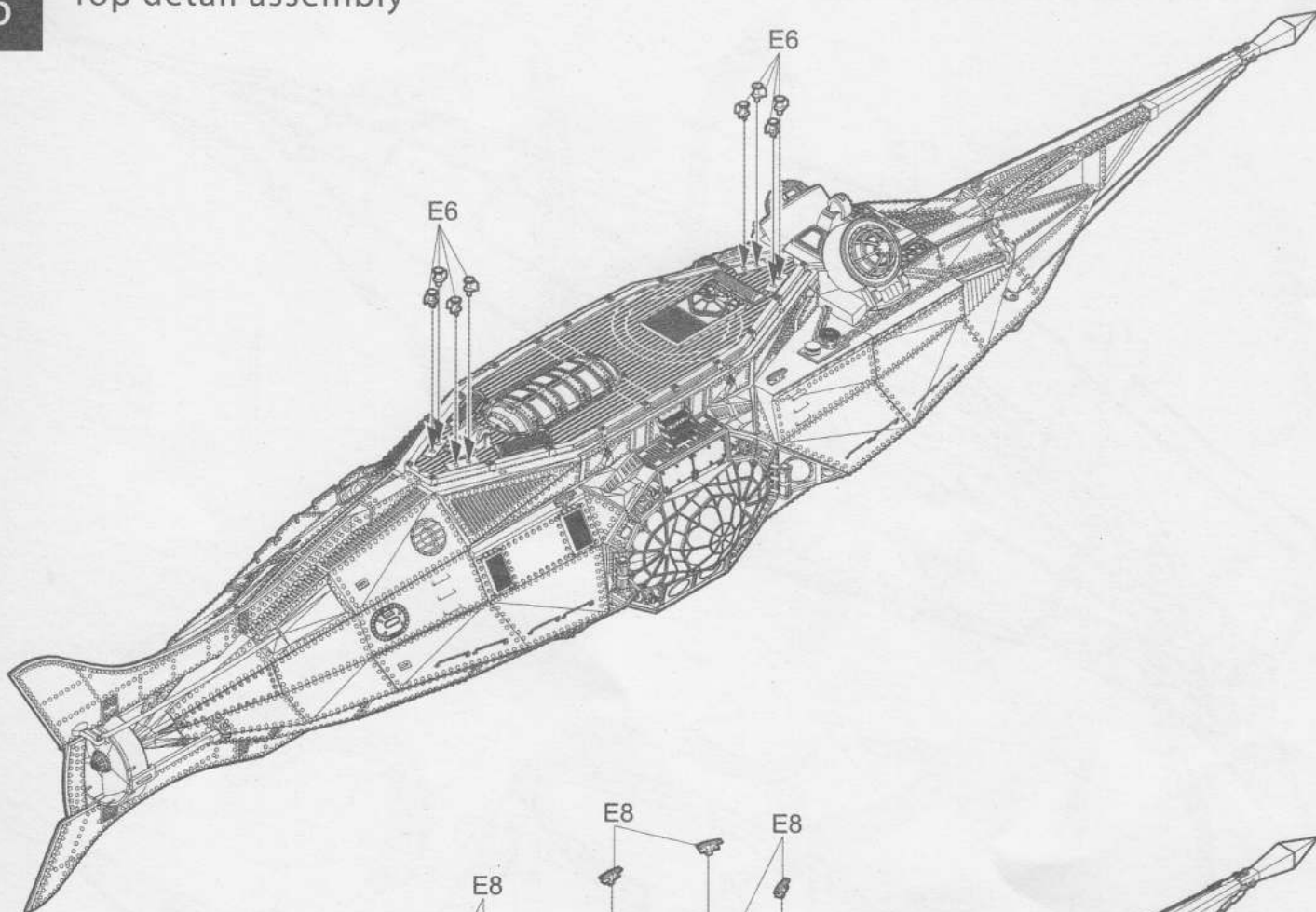


## Prop and side detail assembly

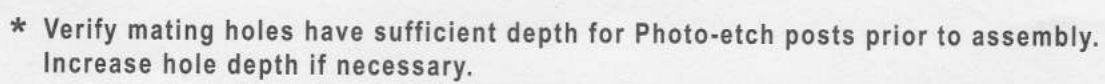

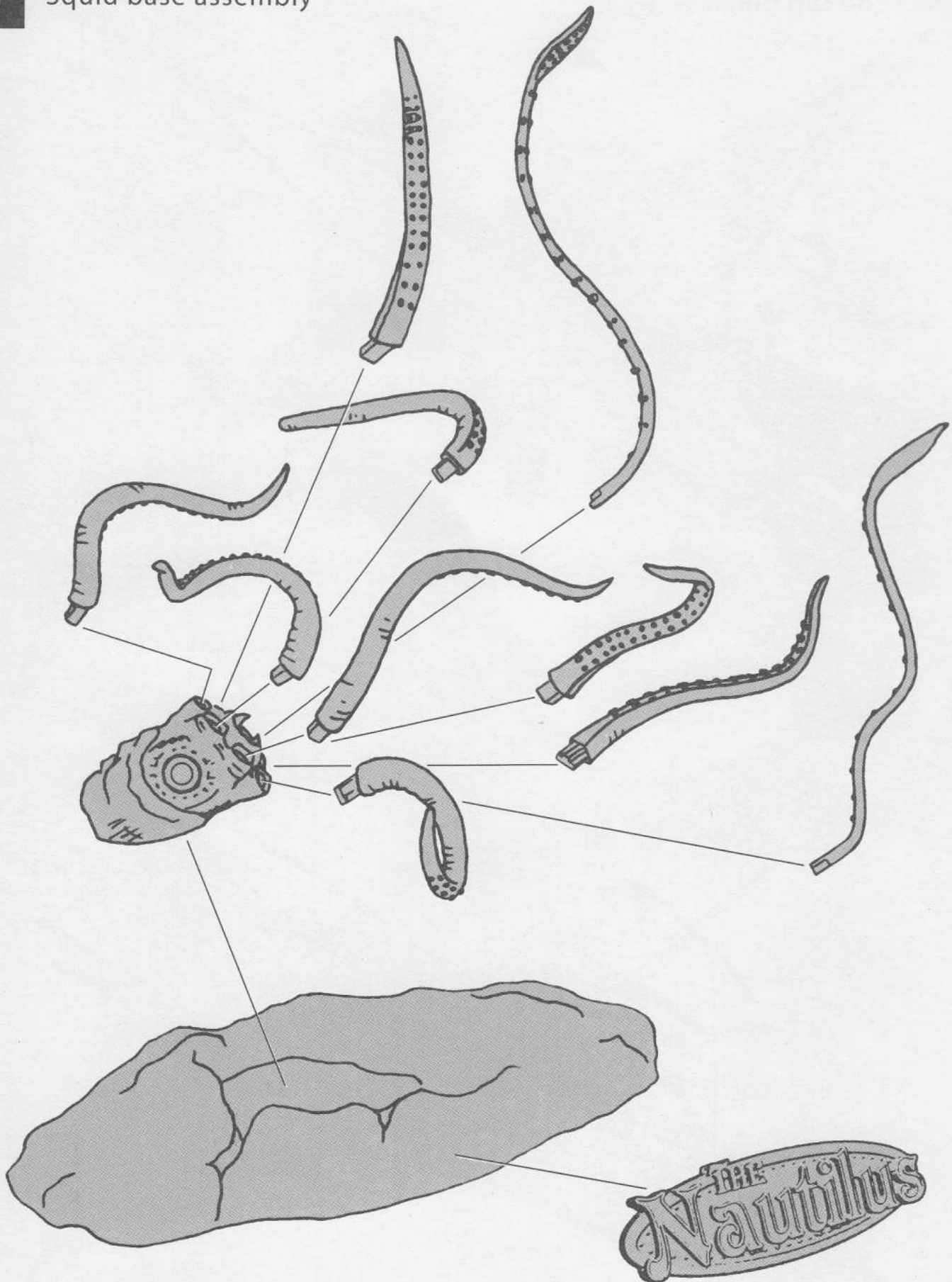


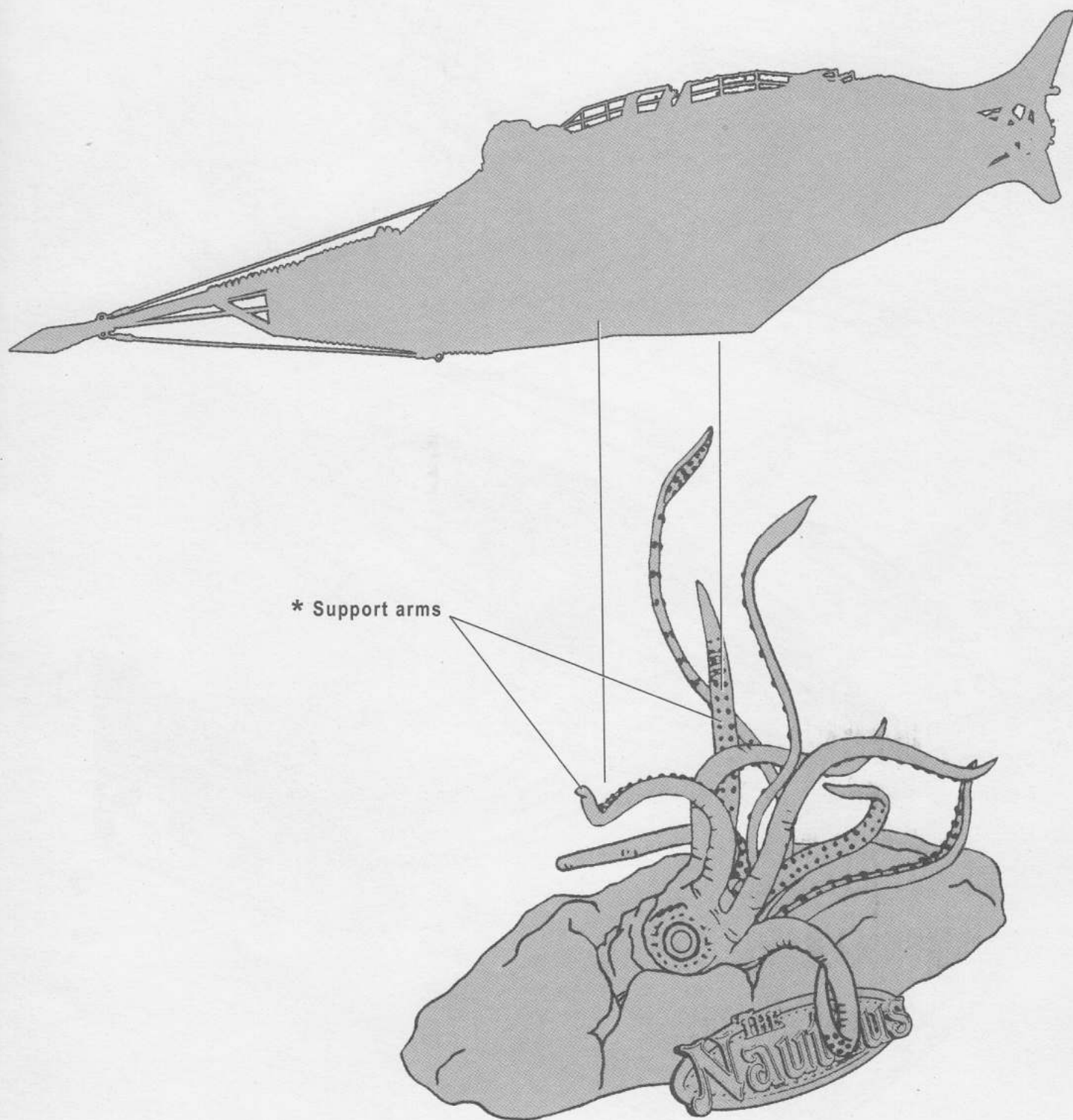










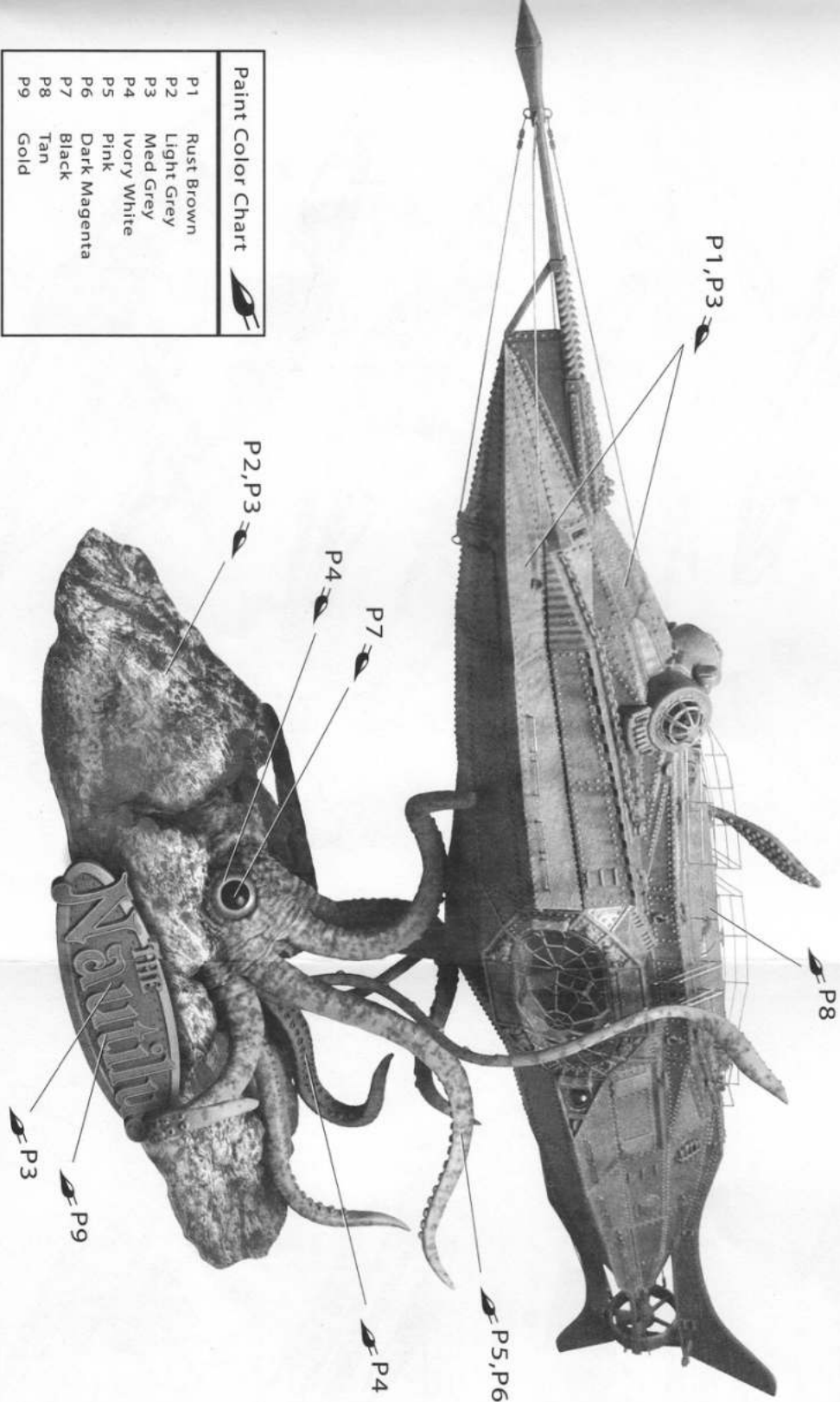


\* Two squid tentacles are designed to support the ship.

## PAINTING GUIDE

To get a really nice finish, make sure you use quality hobby paints and brushes. Take good care of your brushes and clean them well after every time you use them and they will last a long time. Before you paint, be sure to lay down some newspaper in the area you plan on working.

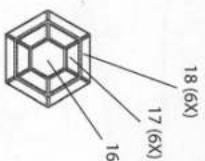
Kit parts are molded in Polystyrene plastic & Vinyl, we recommend using : TAMIYA Extra Thin Cement, MODELMASTER Liquid Cement For Plastic Models (#8872C) or a Cyanoacrylate adhesive for gluing opaque plastic parts together. For clear parts we recommend: Testors Clear Parts Cement or a standard White glue to avoid fogging of parts. For Vinyl parts we recommend using a Cyanoacrylate adhesive or two part Epoxy for gluing parts together. Due to the material and molding process, some parts may be distorted and need to be re-shaped prior to assembly. We recommend submerging distorted parts in warm water or using a blow dryer to heat parts up for re-shaping. Once parts have been heated sufficiently, re-shape to the desired position then cool parts rapidly by submerging them in cold water to set the shape. May require repeating the process to achieve desired results.



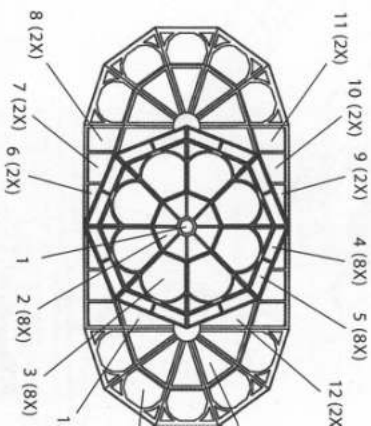
